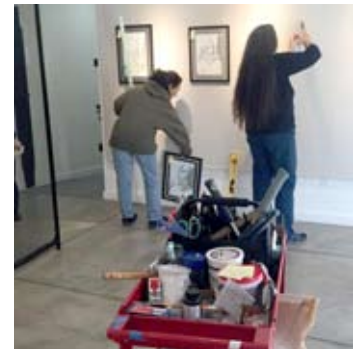
Collage Sketchbook
